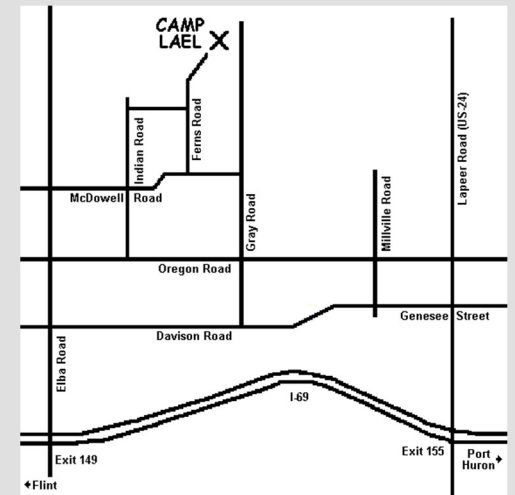
How do I Get to Camp?

From Detroit:

Take I-75 north to the Lapeer-Lake Orion exit (#81). Take M-24 north to Genesee St, turn west. Follow to Gray Rd, turn north. Go to McDowell Rd, turn west. Follow to Ferns Rd, turn north. Follow to Camp Lael.

From Flint:

Take I-69 to Elba Rd. exit (#149), turn north. Follow to McDowell Rd, turn east. Go to Ferns Rd, turn north. Follow to Camp Lael.



Other Information

- Though you have paid a minimum \$50 deposit, it is appreciated if you pay all camp fees before camp begins. If you do not, the balance is due at registration.
- All camper's cash is banked at registration and a "Store Card" with the amount banked is credited for the camper to use.
- Complete and bring the **Health History form** and **Parental/Photo Release form** to camp. **Do not mail** these forms to Camp Lael.
- Make arrangements to have your camper picked up at the time of departure. Early dismissals are not encouraged. Closing programs are held for the following camps prior to departure: Special Needs, Intro, 5th-6th grade, Junior & Senior High camps only.
- We request telephone use by campers for emergency purposes only.
- "Mail Call" is an important event for campers. Send your letters with the camper's name on the envelope to the address. Please do not send email messages to any other staff members.
